6 Steps to Experiencing God's Word

Step 3: **Lead Me** – *Embrace the Plan*

The Living Word needs **to become part of us** and
then go ***WITH*** us!



“Lead Me” means:

1. **Aim Me:** Point me in a direction
2. **Bend Me:** Pressure me like bending a bow
3. **Place Me:** Order my steps

His Leading is Daily

Your **Word** is a *lamp to my feet* and a *light to my path*.

His Leading is Daily

The “God-Path” Is:

1. Your Dispositional Path
2. Your Conversational Path
3. Your Decisional Path

His Leading is Daily

Everyday there is a path to take for the **Glory** and **Honor** of our **Lord and Master**.

His Leading is Internal

¹²For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

His Leading is Internal
