


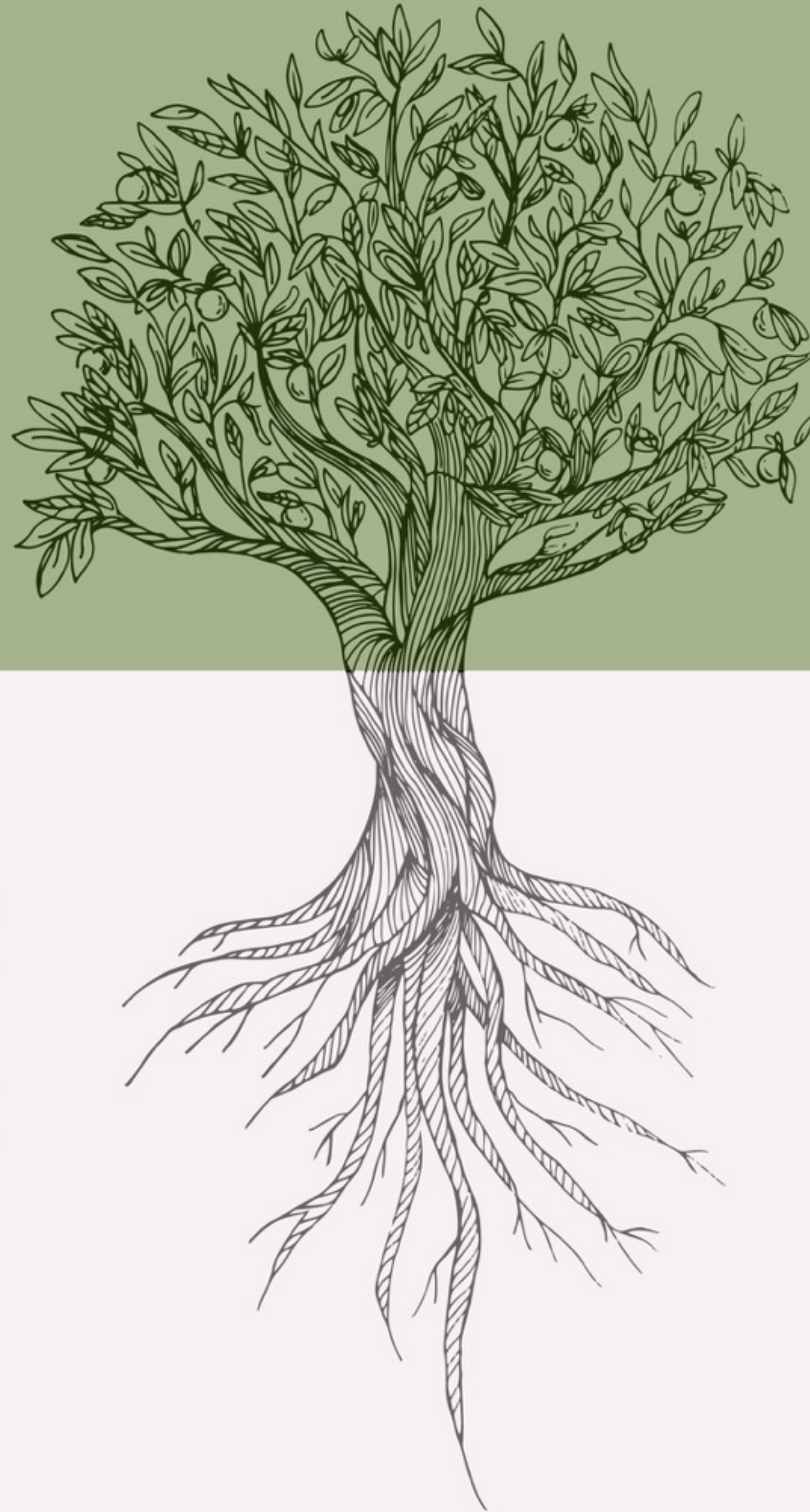
YOUR ANCHOR

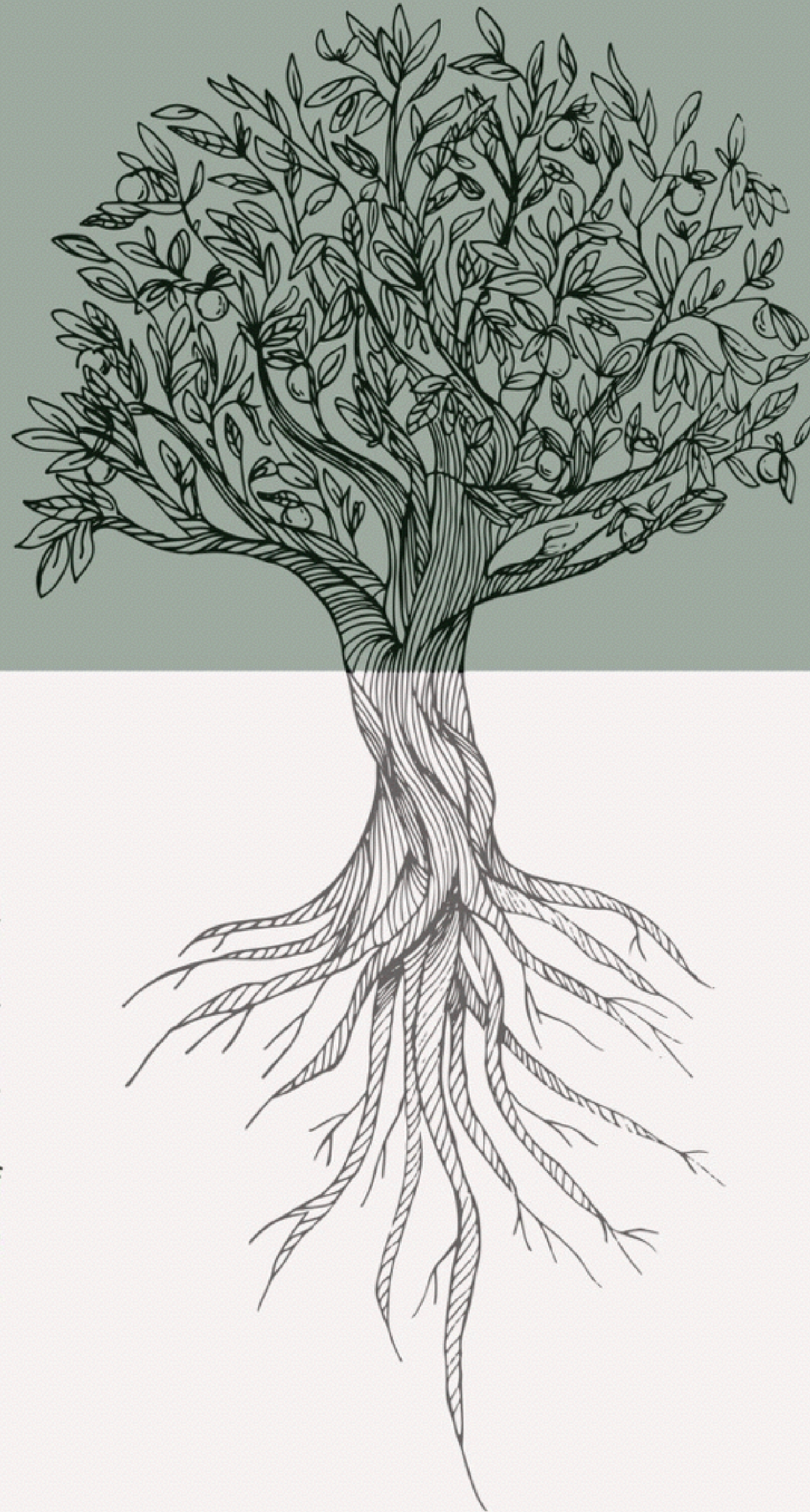

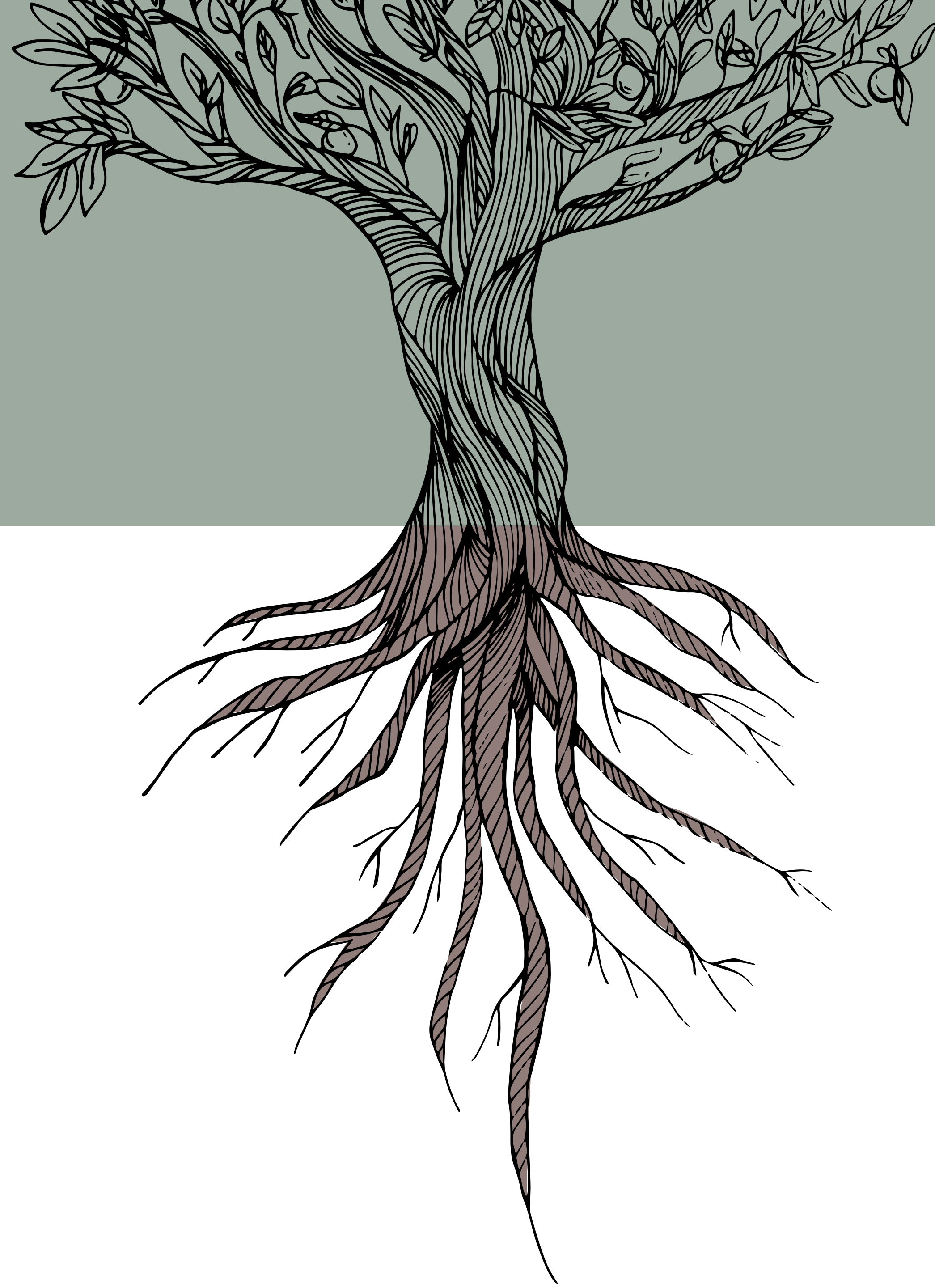


Your Fruit System is the Realm of Service

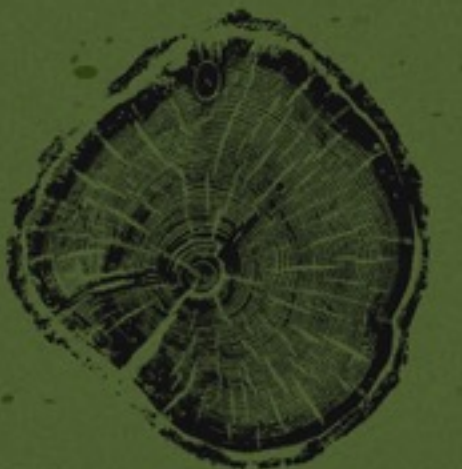
We Anchor Through His Lordship
