Faith Defined

1. Confident Expectation in the Presence, Power, and Provision of the Unseen God (**Faith in the Person of God**).
2. Absolute Belief and Trust in the Command of God (**Faith in the Word of God**).

Escape Clause: is any clause, term, or condition in a contract that allows a party to that contract to avoid having to perform the contract. If an agreement was drawn up for the sale of a house, for example, the purchaser could include some kind of escape clause in the contract, which will allow him to "escape" from the contract without being liable for breach of contract.
