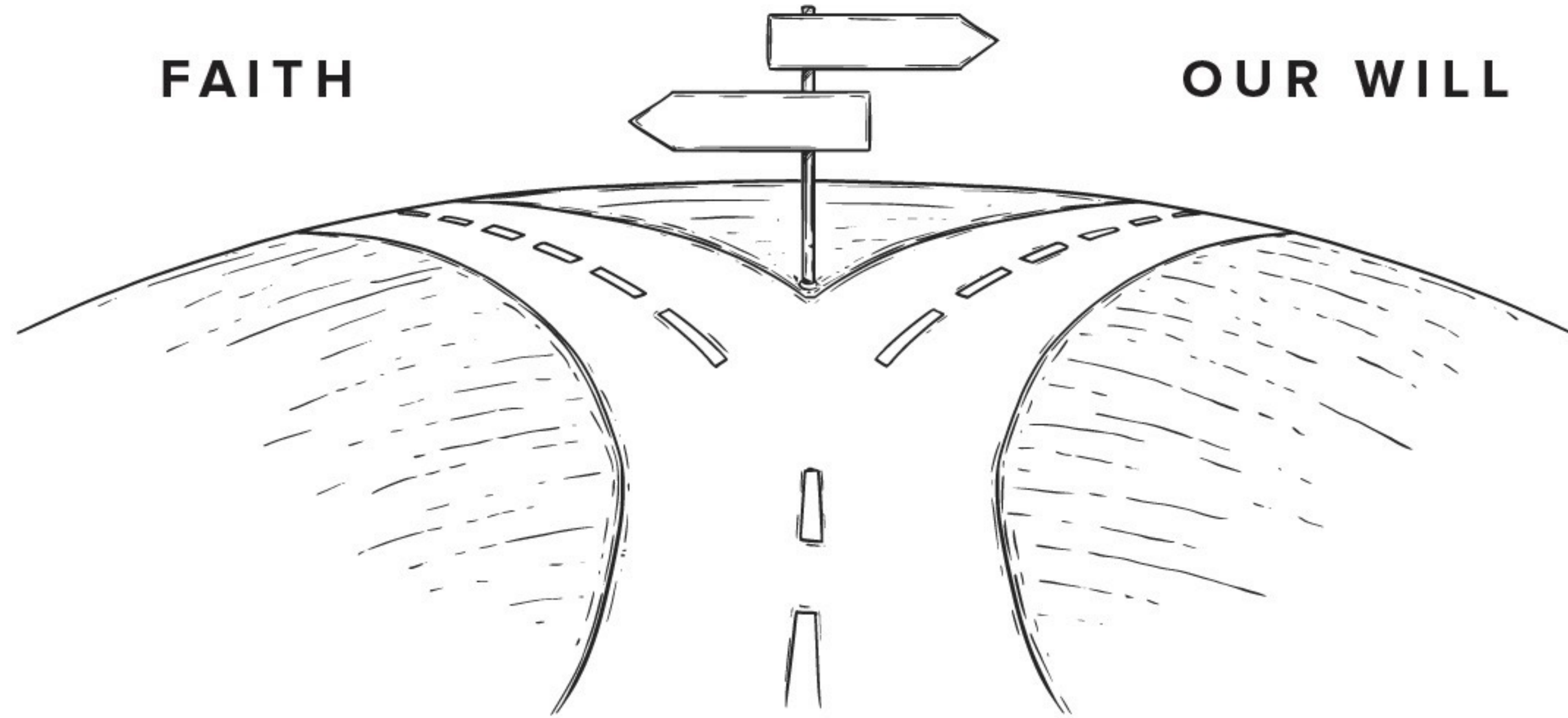
## Faith Defined:

# Faith Chooses the Battle Over Compromise

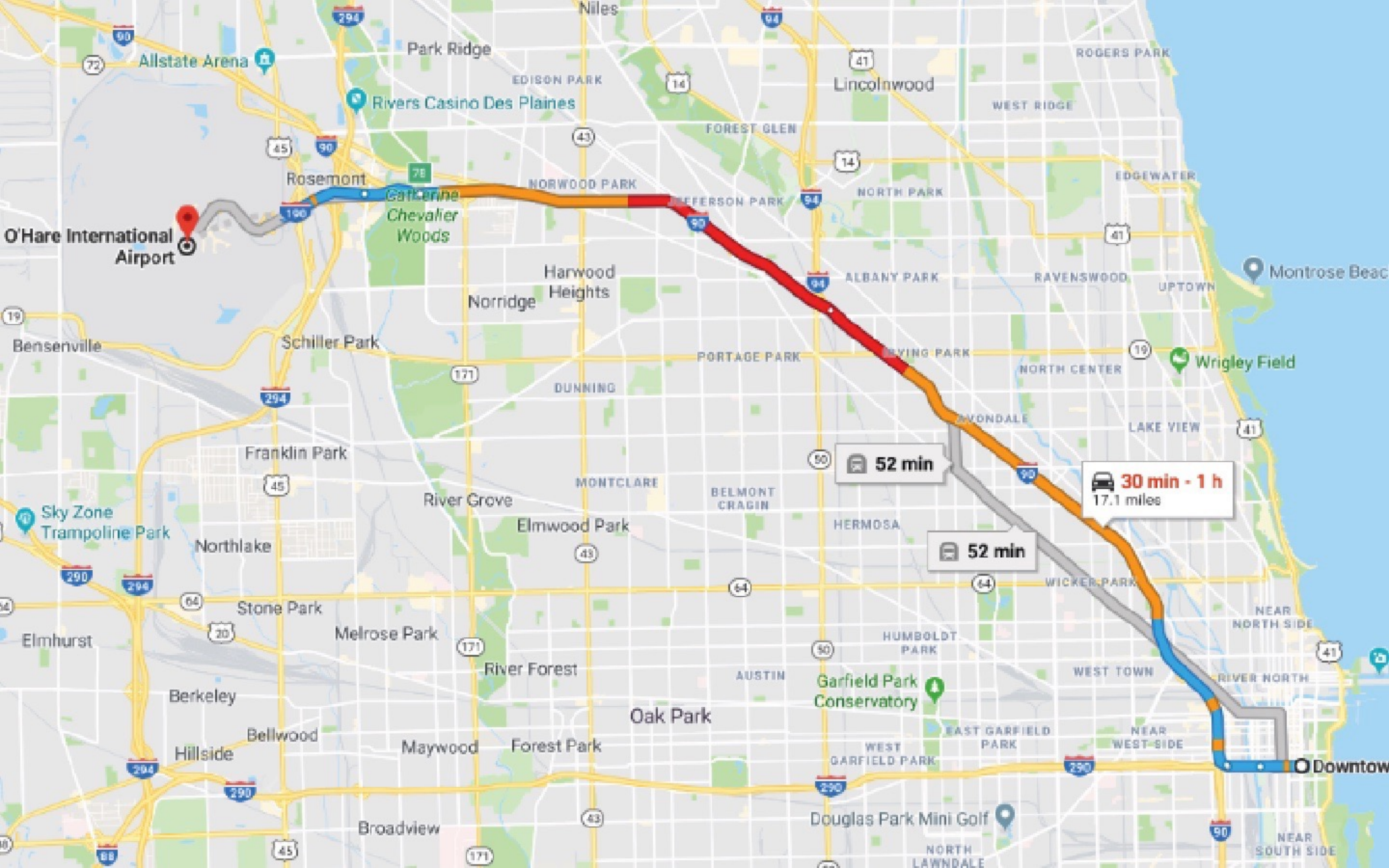

# Faith Chooses the Battle Over Compromise

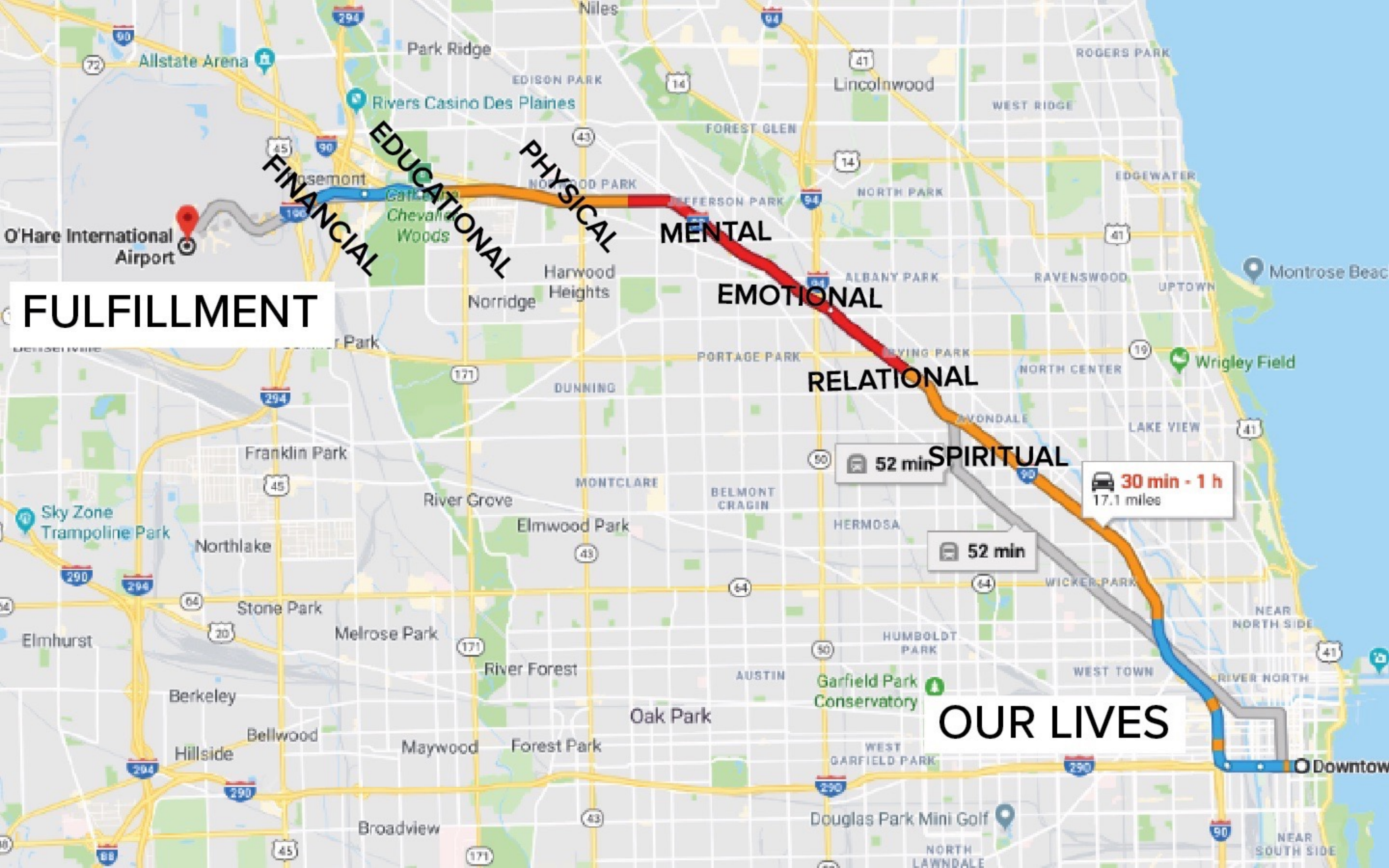
**Compromise:** Settling for anything less than the promise of God for your life. It is redefining reality to make it look like God when it really isn't God.
