Faith Defined:

- 1. Confident Expectation in the Presence, Power, and Provision of the Unseen God (Faith in the Person of God).
- 2. Absolute Belief and Trust in the Command of God (Faith in the Word of God).


Faith Refuses


Faith Refuses The Sonship of Egypt


