

# Rowland Bingham and the Sudan Interior Mission, 1893



While in the Sudan, they received an unprompted gift of \$300 (\$12,000 today) from the will of Mary Jones, a housekeeper.

They used it to enter Inner Sudan against the warnings of other missionaries. Only Bingham survived the journey.

Today SIM has 7000 missionaries in over 70 nations.
