
Merciful: a person who shows leniency, compassion, or forgiveness, especially toward someone who has offended them.



Leniency: a bend, not break attitude when people do you wrong.


Compassion: the ability to understand why people do you wrong when people do you wrong.




### Mercy Chooses to Walk in God's Shoes




