The supernatural ability to ask or think according to <u>God's power</u> working inside of us.






When We Receive Power, He'll Do More Than We Ask

355 B.C. - 323 B.C.




A man once did Alexander the Great a service, and Alelxander told him to ask for any type of reward he wished.


