

John Newton, 1725-1807



1747: Converted during a ship storm when he recalled Proverbs 1: "Because I have called and ye have refused, ... I also will laugh at your calamity."

1769: Began pastoring and felt led to start writing hymns.

1787: Wrote, *Thoughts Upon the Slave Trade,* which led to the abolition of slavery in British colonies in 1807.
