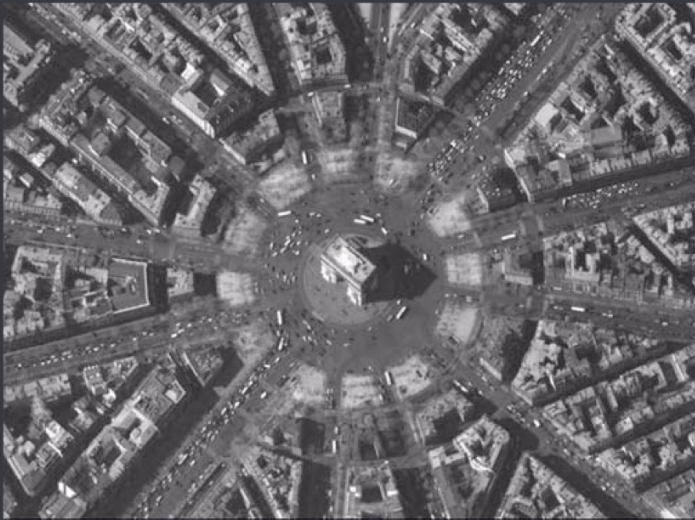

Daniel 10:16,19 (NET)

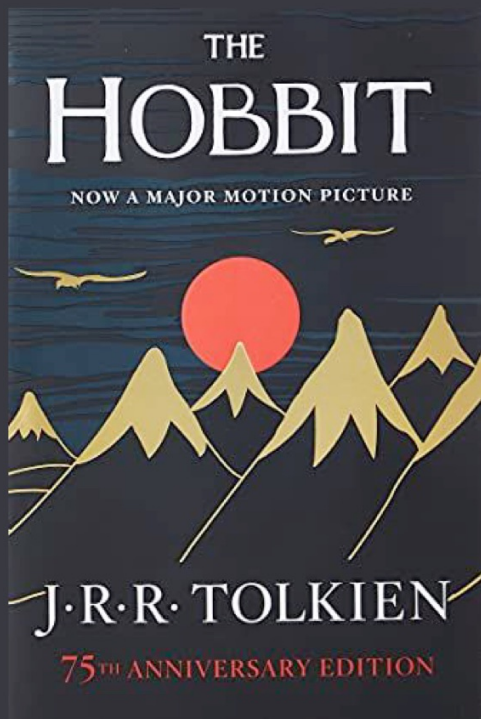
