

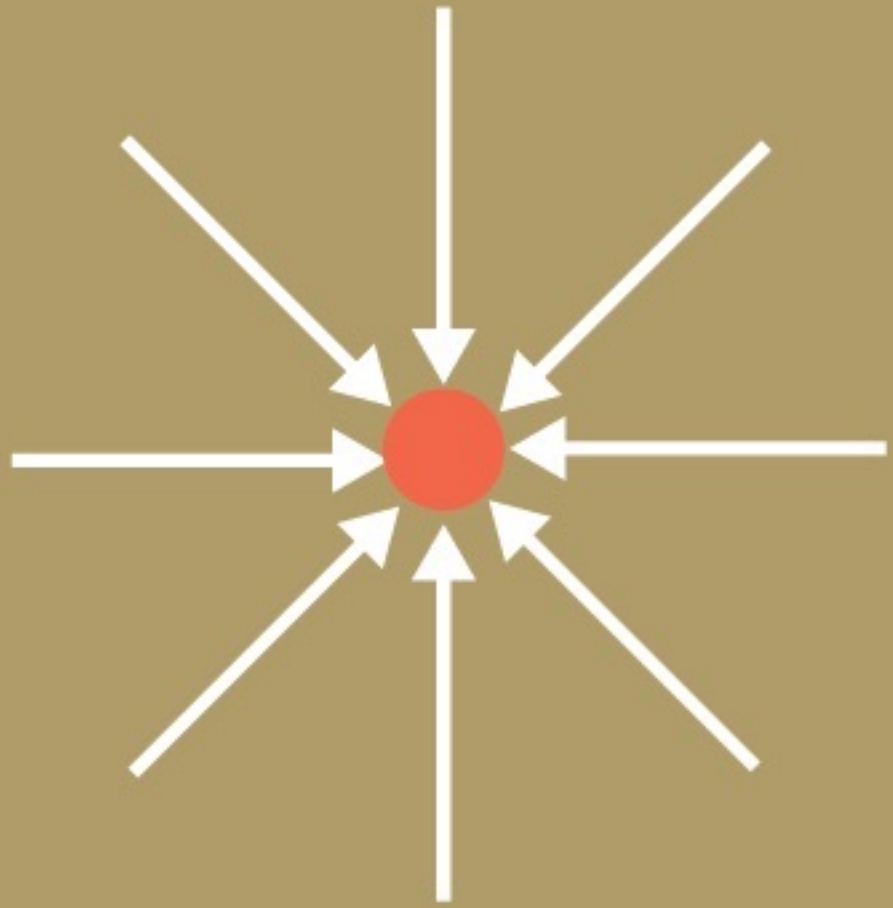

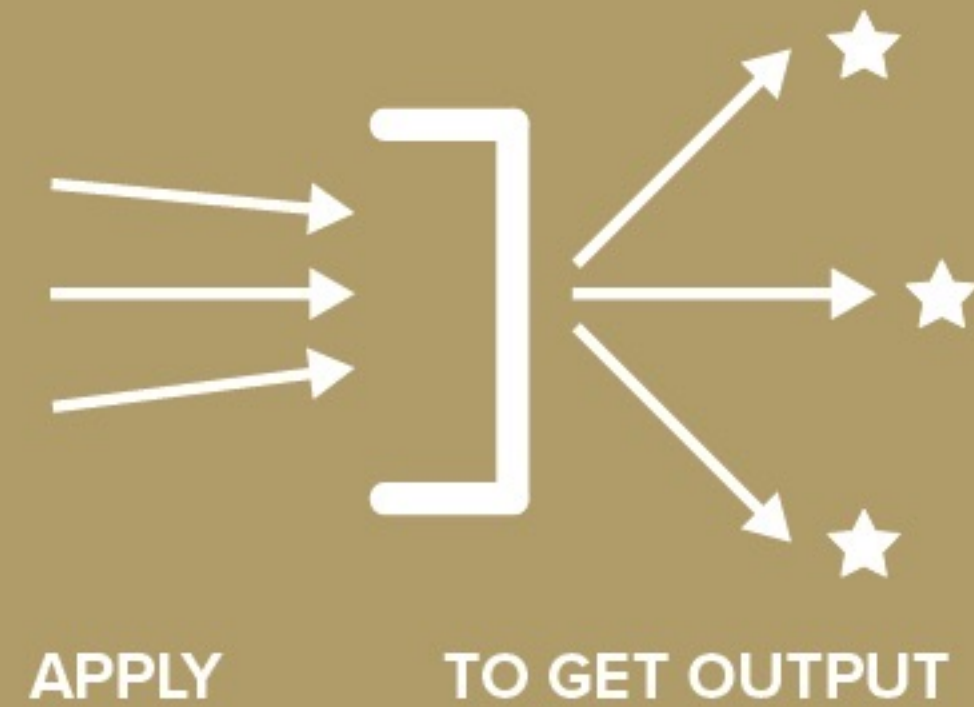

## 1. CONSUME



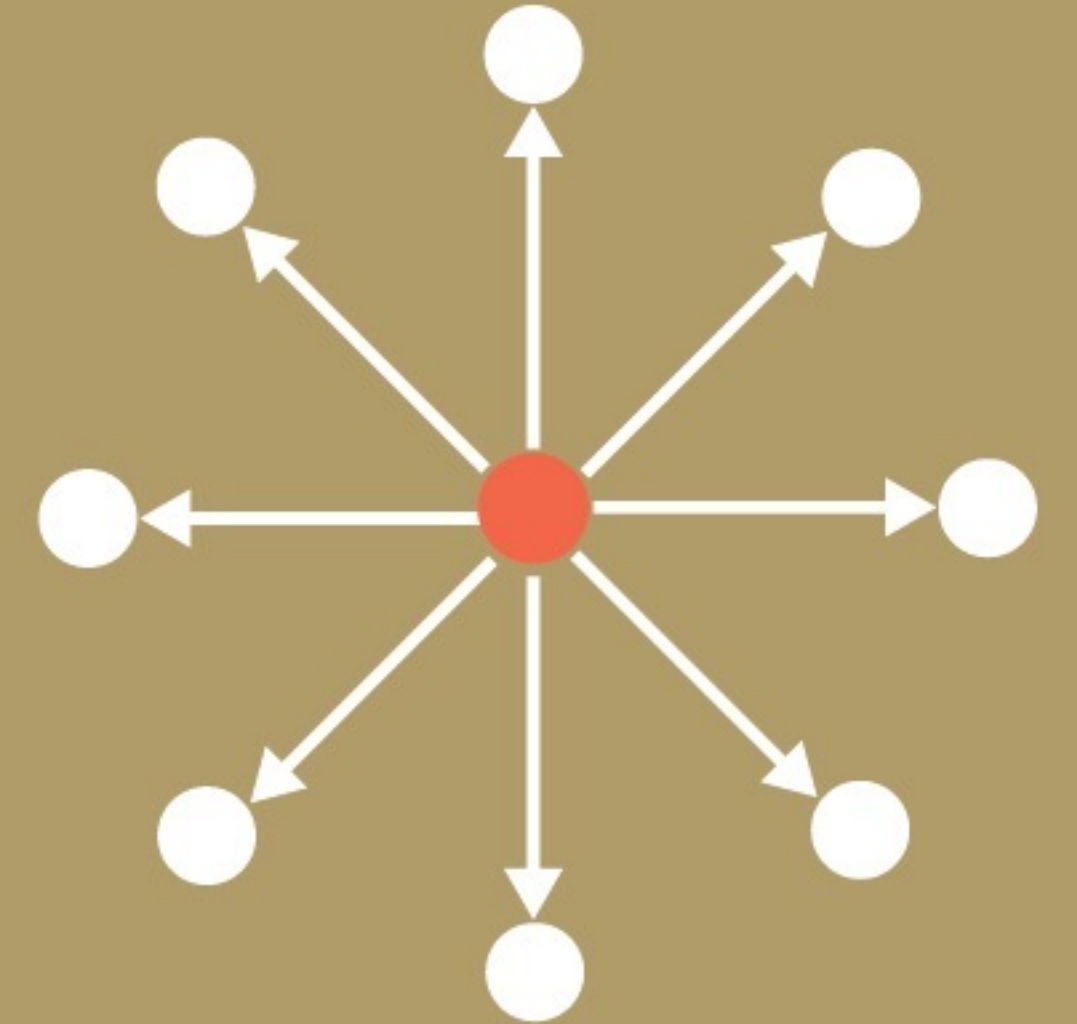

**Roy Williams, Michael Jordan's Assistance Coach at North Carolina, was asked what he thought Michael Jordan's best skill was.**

**He didn't say it was his ability to dunk from the free throw line or his scoring ability. His answer:**

**"He was coachable. He was a sponge and aggressive to learn."**





**When Phil Jackson took over as Bulls coach, he implemented the Triangle Offense. He warned Jordan that this would mean less shots for Jordan, who had won multiple scoring titles already.**
