Pomare II, King of Huahine and Tahiti, 1782-1821



In 1811, he became a Christian as the result of missionary efforts from Henry Bicknell, William Henry, and Charles Wilson from the London Missionary Society.

Pomare discovered a plot among his fellow natives to seize him and other converts and burn them to death. He organized a band to attack the plotters, captured them unaware and then set a feast before them. This unexpected kindness surprised the savages, who burned their idols and became Christians.
