CSL Director

• The CSL Director is expected to oversee the CSL Program aimed at raising a generation of young adult ministry leaders. The Director serves as a role model and is expected to live above reproach while demonstrating diligence, generosity, hospitality and compassion. The Director is expected but not limited to: market the CSL Program; recruit students; provide spiritual guidance and Biblical instruction; develop curriculum; facilitate leadership development of students; oversee the Chicago School of Leadership; create a vibrant community to foster student engagement.

Key Responsibilities

- Market CSL directly to the congregations at Chicago Tabernacle and Philadelphia Tabernacle and via internal ministries e.g. Next Generation, The Free.
- Market CSL through speaking engagements, presentations at other churches, camps, fairs, expos, etc.
- Recruit students.
- Supervise CSL Program Manager
- Provide spiritual direction for CSL staff and students.
- Disciple students.
- Enhance and develop systems to train and develop students holistically.
- Develop and oversee avenues of connection that foster a vibrant student life environment.
- Guide Bible studies and teach as required.
- Develop curriculum
- Lead/oversee student chapel.
- Assess student practicum with an emphasis on quality assurance.
- Actively promulgate the principles of *DNA* of a Leader.
